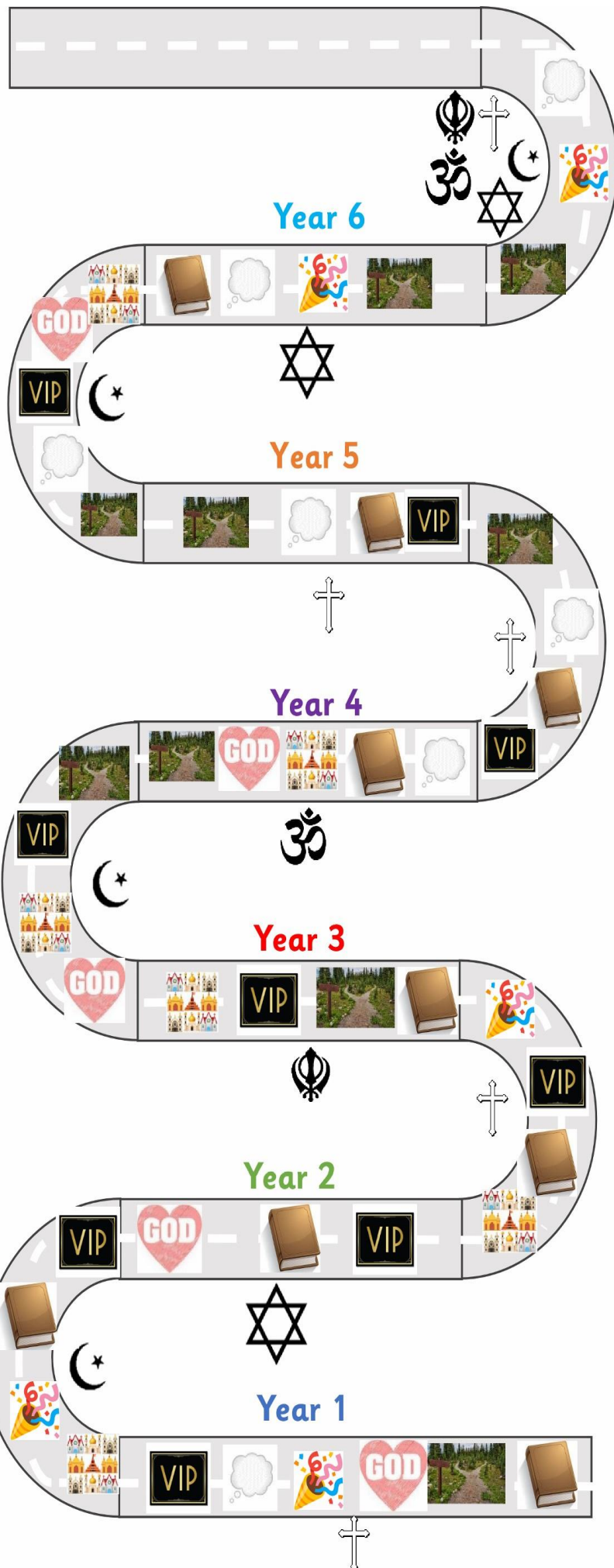


Whinney Banks Primary School RE Road Map

Y3	Christianity, religious objects, such as the importance of the crucifix, the Ichthus fish symbol, the dove, the communion bread and wine. The children take part in a Christingle service in our local church. Hinduism, linked to religious and non-religious beliefs as well as in the Hindu religion. Religious stories, special places, festivals, Gods, symbols and Karma and reincarnation.
Y4	Christianity comparison of religious artefacts with other religions, the creation of the world and if the children would change how it was made and why, traditions, stories, places of worship, important people. Islam, knowledge of the religion verses the beliefs within the religion, Five pillars, special objects, e.g. The Qur'an, special celebrations and important people.
Y5	Christianity how the religion relates to individuals, teachings and authority, symbols and religious expressions, inspirational people, family and community, worship, life and death. Sikhism, beliefs, God, community, the 5K's, ceremonies, duties and prayers, celebrations, compare and contrast the religions taught. Judaism linked to their WWII history topic.
Y6	Christianity, place of worship and the significance and importance of artefacts, how God, the world and other influence our lives, compare and contrast the religions of Christianity and Buddhism. Buddhism, faiths, beliefs and practices, the 3 jewels, reincarnation, enlightenment, celebrations.
