WB Reading Fluency

Teacher-led, modelled fluent reading	Opportunity for pupils to hear a good model of how a text sounds when read fluently with prosody.
Choral reading	Reading simultaneously with a child, groups of children or the whole class.
Repeated choral reading	Adults phase out their voice, gradually releasing responsibility to the pupils.
Echo reading	Reading short sections for children to echo back.
Partner reading	Choral or echo reading in pairs - stronger readers paired with struggling readers.
Deep reading	Individuals reading a text repeatedly, this may be silently or aloud.
Performance reading	Pupils use text marking to show how they will use their voice, then rehearse and perform their reading.
